

This is a very clean, unmodified HRO-500, serial # 75-1070, always stored in its fiberglass transit case by the original owner. The original manual is in excellent condition, along with an original specification sheet, a specification sheet with a typed note from National offering a factory reconditioned unit to the buyer due to delays in the HRO-600 production and a marketing glossy 8x10 photograph of the unit and transit case. The original power cord and feet are included.

1. The radio has not been cleaned or modified as far as we know and is in original condition as received by the owner. The original purchase date is not known.
2. Knobs have no significant wear marks and the controls function. The front panel has no scratches or wear and should clean up very nicely with minimal effort. The case is clean and free of rust, as are the internal chassis and components. The bottom cover has not been removed for inspection.
3. The PLO does lock, but obviously needs alignment and updates.
4. Sensitivity at 10 MHz is about 20 microvolts, so the front end obviously needs some work.
5. The S-meter appears to be in good condition, but there is no meter movement with a strong signal.
6. The unit is being sold AS-IS by the Orange County Radio Amateurs club (OCRA) in Chapel Hill, NC, 27516, with the understanding that the buyer is aware that updates and alignment, as typical for this radio, will be required to restore full functionality.
